

protect Maine waters by following the simple steps below.



**CLEAN** off all plants (even small fragments), animals and mud from boat, trailer, and equipment.

**RAIN** water from boat, motor, bilge, live wells and other equipment well away from water.

**D**RY boat and gear completely to kill hard to see smallbodied organisms. If you can't dry equipment, rinsing with hot, high pressure water will also remove many smallbodied organisms.

**NEVER** release plants, live fish or animals into a water body unless they came out of that body of water.
